From M20 eastbound, leave at junction 2

From M20 westbound, join the M26 and leave immediately at junction 2A

From M26 east- or westbound, leave at junction 2A

Then in each case follow signs for A227 towards Meopham and Gravesend.

From the M2/A2 turn southwards onto the A227, & pass through Meopham.

Vigo RFC is just east of Vigo Village.

The entrance will be marked with archery target signs on the day.

Rounds:

The rounds to be shot will be:

Saturday 7th July WRS WA70m, WA60m and WA50m ranking round with individual H2H

Sunday 8th July World Archery 1440 rounds, which will have
UK and World Record Status and World Archery Star Status **plus**
ArcheryGB Metric rounds, which will have UK Record Status only.

GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

Eligibility: This tournament is open only to archers who are existing members of ArcheryGB or another World Archery member association.

Proof of membership will be requested at the tournament, **no proof no entry.**

Club: Because this event is organised by a county association, you must enter the tournament either as a member of your first-claim club (GNAS Law 20.b.v) or as a Direct Member of KAA/other county/ArcheryGB (provided, of course, that you are).

Entry: Priority will be given to those archers booking into both days.

Awards: Awards will be given in all categories according to the number of entries received and will only be available to competitors who shoot the round that starts with the recognised maximum distance for their gender & age. Awards will be presented as soon as possible after completion of shooting on the 2nd day and will be based upon your combined score and position.

Drug Testing: This is a UK and World Record Status tournament. You might be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If you refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under the age of 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify consent to their child being drug tested.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR): When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

Dress Code: ArcheryGB dress regulations will apply. Archers not conforming to rule 307 will not be eligible for awards. You are requested to observe the dress code until after the presentation of awards.

Shooting Aids: Archers using a wheelchair or stool that remain on the line please complete the box on the form so that this can be accommodated.

Lost Arrows: This tournament is held on a mixed-use sports field; if you lose any arrows, you must find them before you leave the venue.

Disclaimer: Neither the Kent Archery Association nor the owners of the grounds can accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or property while on, entering or leaving the venue. No responsibility will be accepted for damage to arrows missing or passing through a target boss.

Parking: Parking space will be clearly indicated; please park considerately and do not leave your car on any roadway.

Photography: To comply with the ArcheryGB Policy for "Safeguarding Children, Young People & Vulnerable Adults", any person wishing to pursue any form of photography for any purpose is required to report to the tournament organiser before starting and to comply with any conditions given.

Juniors: All competitors under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or other nominated responsible adult at all times.

Privacy Policy: Personal information supplied by you on the entry form will only be used for the purposes of this tournament as outlined above in the section on GDPR.

Closing Date for Entries: Sunday, 1st July 2018, The closing date will be strictly adhered to – late entries and substitutions will not be accepted. Once full a waiting list will apply to entries received before the closing date.

Entries can only be accepted if they include adequate contact details, the archer's signature (plus parent/guardian's signature for juniors) and full payment. Postal entries only. Target list and results will be available on the KAA website only.

WA1440 ENTRY INFORMATION

Age Groups: Archers wishing to be considered for a *World Archery Star* or *World Record* must shoot the WA round corresponding to their age on the birthday that falls in the year of the tournament. All may choose to shoot the senior round.

Age Groups: Juniors who do not wish to compete in the above rounds may elect to shoot the ArcheryGB Metric round corresponding to their gender and age, in which case they will be eligible only for *UK Records*. Archers entering the rounds below are not eligible for Star awards.

Star Awards: World Archery rounds (Table 1) have 'World Archery Star' status and competitors wishing to claim an award, must do so before they leave the venue.

Practice: 09:30 a.m.

Start of Competition: 10:15 a.m.

Targets: All target butts are constructed from bound straw ropes; 4-leg (H-frame) stands are used throughout.

Target Faces: At the two shortest distances, sighted bows 4 x 80cm 6 zone with A, C shooting on the left, B, D on the right. Unsighted bows 1 x 80cm 10 zone face.

Timing: Shooting will be in descending order of distance and in two details throughout. Ends of 6 arrows will be shot in 4 minutes at all distances.

WA720 + H2H ENTRY INFORMATION

The Rounds: WA70m (Recurve), WA60m (Cadet Recurve), WA50m Compound ranking round followed by individual match play rounds (H2H). Please note that it is expected the top 32 archers in each category will progress to the match play rounds.

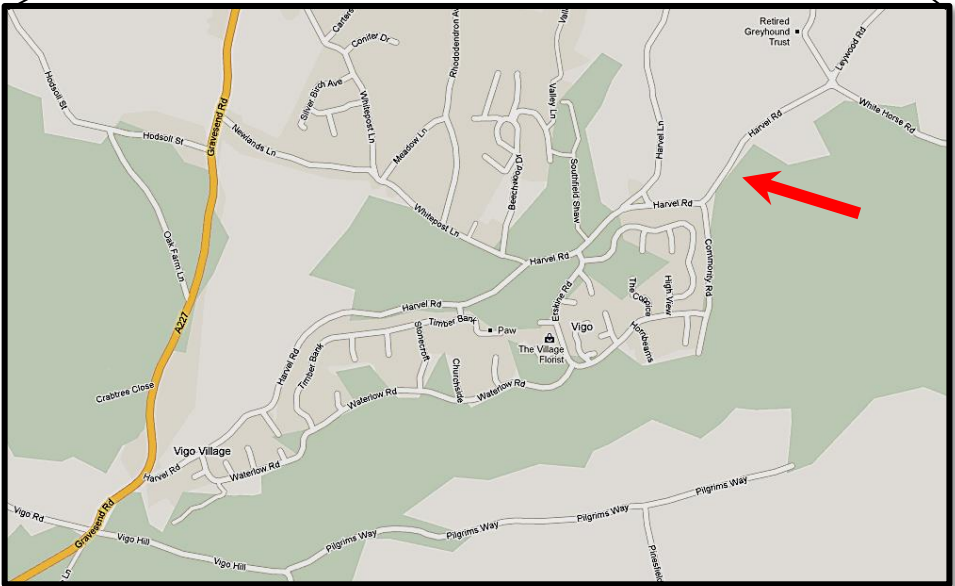
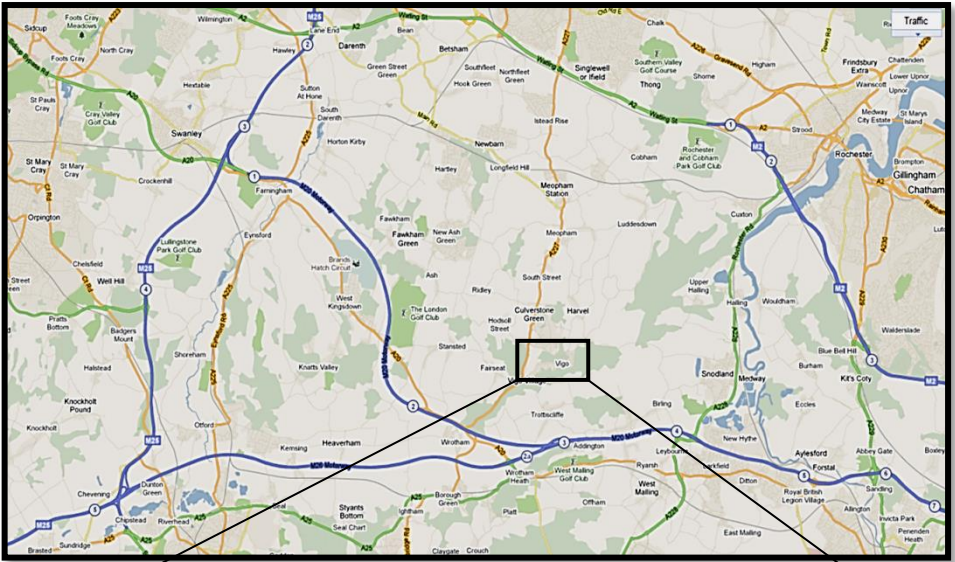
Targets: All target butts are constructed from bound straw ropes; 4-leg stands are used throughout.
