Qualification

This tournament is open to all archers who are existing members of ArcheryGB and have a disability. ArcheryGB cards will need to be produced on the day.

Rounds:

Adults: Western
(4doz @ 60 yards, 4doz @ 50 yards)

Juniors: Short Junior Western
(4doz @ 30 yards, 4doz @ 20 yards)

Visually Impaired: Burntwood Western
(Senior) (4doz on 60 cm, 4doz on 80 cm @ 30 metres)
(Junior) (4doz on 80 cm, 4doz on 122 cm @ 15metres)

Adults may shoot the junior round, subject to space availability, but this will not qualify for awards.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded according to the normal Kent Archery Association rules, and so will be dependant on the number of entries received in each class. Trophies will be awarded, to retain for one year, subject to the level of sponsorship received.

Classifications Shooting the Western rounds

Archery Standing (ARST): Archers having Physical or Mental impairment shooting in the Standing Classification. Archers in this class may choose to compete sitting in an ordinary chair with their feet on the ground or standing. The legs show some degree of loss of muscle strength, co-ordination and/or joint mobility. **Archery Wheelchair 1 (ARW1):** Archers in the ARW1 class have a disability in their arms and legs (tetraplegia). They have limited range of movement, strength and control of their arms and poor or non-existing control of the trunk. The legs are considered non-functional, due to amputation and/or similar limitations of movement, strength and control. They compete in a wheelchair.

Archery Wheelchair 2 (ARW2): Archers in the ARW2 class have paraplegia and limited mobility in the lower limbs. These athletes require a wheelchair for everyday use and compete in a wheelchair.

The above classifications are as laid down by ArcheryGB, FITA and the IPC
