Sunday, 19 August 2007 at Leigh City Technology College (East Campus), Green Street Green Road, Dartford, Kent DA1 1QE

When travelling south from the roundabout by Hesketh Park, the East Campus will be on your left.

The entrance to the college will be signposted from Green St. Green Road about 150m from the roundabout, near the college footbridge.

Rounds:

The rounds to be shot will be York, Hereford and all Bristol rounds according to the sex and age of the competitor.

This tournament has GNAS National Record and Rose Award status, with the exception of the Bristol 5 round.

Eligibility: Only Archers affiliated to GNAS or another FITA member association are eligible to shoot; proof of membership may be requested at the tournament.

Entries will be accepted in all GNAS-recognised age groups and styles except crossbow. Entries cannot be accepted from professionals.

Drug Testing: This is a GNAS National Record Status tournament. Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under the age of 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

The Rounds: York, Hereford and all Bristol rounds, but please note that the Bristol 5 round is not recognised for National Record or Rose Awards.

Dress Code: GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain dark green / white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Archers are requested to observe the dress regulations until after the presentation of awards.

Awards: Tournament awards will be made in all categories according to the number of entries received and will only be available to competitors who shoot the round that starts with the recognised maximum distance for their sex and age.

Juniors may not compete for senior awards, but separate awards will also be available for juniors who wish to shoot the senior round.

Some awards are available only to members of the Kent Archery Association, others only to 'visitors', and some are open to all.

Awards will be presented by the Lady Paramount as soon as possible after completion of shooting.

Rose Awards: This tournament has 'Rose Award' status and competitors wishing to claim an award, must do so before they leave the venue.

Lost Arrows: The tournament is held on a mixed-use sports field; all lost arrows must be found before their owner leaves the venue.

Disclaimer: Neither the Kent Archery Association nor Leigh City Technology College can accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment while on, entering or leaving the venue. No responsibility will be accepted for damage to arrows missing or passing through a target boss.

Parking: Parking space will be clearly sign-posted; cars must not be left or parked on any roadway.

Photography: To comply with the GNAS Child & Vulnerable Adults Protection Policy, any person wishing to pursue any form of photography for any purpose, is required to report to the tournament organiser before starting and to comply with any conditions required.
