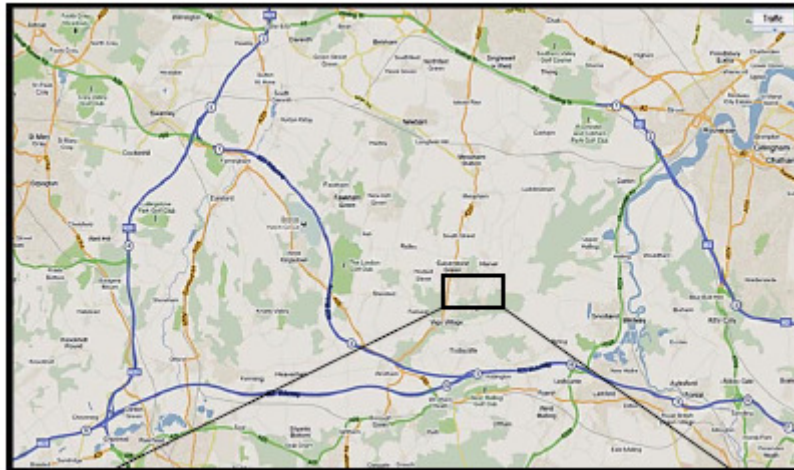

Entry Form

for the

59th Kent Target Championship and Open Tournament

Sunday 19th August 2012

at

**Vigo Rugby Football Club,
Swanswood, Harvel Road, Vigo Village DA13 0UA**

Directions:

From M20 eastbound, leave at junction 2

From M20 westbound, join the M26 and leave immediately at junction 2A

From M26 east- or westbound, leave at junction 2A

Then in each case follow signs for A227 towards Meopham and Gravesend.
From the M2/A2 turn southwards onto the A227, & pass through Meopham.

Vigo RFC is just east of Vigo Village.

The entrance will be marked with archery target signs on the day.

Rounds:

The rounds to be shot will be the York, Hereford and all Bristol rounds according to

the sex and age of the competitor.

National Record and Rose Award status has been granted.

Shooting will be strictly according to the GNAS Rules of Shooting.

Registration: from 08:00 a.m.
Assembly: 09:15 a.m.
Sighters: 09:30 a.m.
Judges: Neil Dimmock(Chairman), Mark Davis
Lady Paramount: TBA
Targets: All target butts are constructed from bound straw and 4-leg stands are used throughout.

Dress Code: Record status dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply; archers not complying will **NOT** be eligible for awards. Traditional dark green / white or club shooting colours are preferred and Archers are requested to observe the dress code until after presentation of awards.

Awards: Awards will be given in all categories according to the number of entries received and will only be available to competitors who shoot the round that starts with the recognised maximum distance for their gender & age.

To qualify for Kent Veteran awards, you must be aged 55 or over on the date of the tournament, declare it on the entry form and shoot the specified distance.

Juniors may **not** compete for senior awards, but separate awards will also be available for juniors who wish to shoot the senior round.

Some awards are available only to members of the Kent Archery Association, others only to 'visitors', and some are open to all. Awards will be presented as soon as possible after completion of shooting.

Rose Awards: This tournament has 'Rose Award' status and competitors wishing to claim an award, must do so before they leave the venue.

Lost Arrows: The tournament is held on a mixed-use sports field; all lost arrows must be found before their owner leaves the venue.

Disclaimer: Neither the Kent Archery Association nor the owners of the grounds can accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment while on, entering or leaving the venue. No responsibility will be accepted for damage to arrows missing or passing through a target boss.

Parking: Parking space will be clearly indicated; please park considerately and do not leave your car on any roadway.

Photography: To comply with the GNAS Policy for Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults, any person wishing to pursue any form of photography for any purpose is required to report to the tournament organiser before starting and to comply with any conditions given.

Juniors: All competitors under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or other responsible adult at all times.

Privacy Policy: Personal information supplied by you on the entry form will only be used for the purposes of this tournament and to inform you about this tournament in future years, unless you have indicated on the form that your email address can be used for additional purposes. No information will be disclosed to third parties, except as required by law.

Eligibility: Only archers affiliated to GNAS/ArcheryGB or another FITA member association are eligible to shoot; proof of membership may be requested at the tournament. Entries will be accepted in all nationally recognised age groups and styles except crossbow.

Drug Testing: This is a National Record Status tournament. Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under the age of 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

The Rounds: York, Hereford and all Bristol rounds. Equivalent

Timing: Shooting will be in two ends each of 3 arrows in 2½ minutes in accordance with GNAS rule 304(f)(i) method 1 – the traditional way.
