Directions:

From M20 eastbound, leave at junction 2
From M20 westbound, join the M26 and leave immediately at junction 2A
From M26 east- or westbound, leave at junction 2A
Then in each case follow signs for A227 towards Meopham and Gravesend.
From the M2/A2 turn southwards onto the A227, & pass through Meopham.
Vigo RFC is just east of Vigo Village.

The entrance will be marked with archery target signs on the day.

Rounds:

The rounds to be shot will be the York, Hereford and all Bristol rounds according to the sex and age of the competitor.

National Record and Rose Award status has been granted.

Shooting will be strictly according to the GNAS Rules of Shooting.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Eligibility: This tournament is open only to archers who are existing members of ArcheryGB or another World Archery member association.

Proof of membership may be requested at the tournament.

Club: Because this event is organised by a county association, you must enter the tournament either as a member of your first-claim club (GNAS Law 20.b.v) or as a Direct Member of KAA/other county/ArcheryGB (provided, of course, that you are).

Drug Testing: This is a UK Record Status tournament. You might be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If you refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under the age of 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify consent to their child being drug tested.

Timing: Shooting will be in two ends each of 3 arrows in 2½ minutes in accordance with GNAS rule 304(f)(i) method 1 – the traditional way!

Veterans: To qualify for Kent Veteran awards, you must be aged 55 or over on the date of the tournament and declare it on the entry form!!!

Entries can only be accepted if they include adequate contact details, the archer's signature (plus parent/guardian's signature for juniors), ArcheryGB number and full payment. Postal entries only. Para-Archers who require special arrangements should bring this to the attention of the Tournament Organiser at the time of entry. Due to a change to the layout this year, ALL targets will be 4 Archers per target, which may limit the amount of entries we can accept. Target list and results will be available on the KAA website only.

Targets:	All target butts are constructed from bound straw ropes; 4-leg (H-frame) stands are used throughout
Dress Code:	ArcheryGB dress regulations as shown in the 'Rules of Shooting' will apply as if this were a National Record Status tournament, but traditional dark green / white or club shooting colours are preferred. You are requested to observe the dress code until after the presentation of awards.

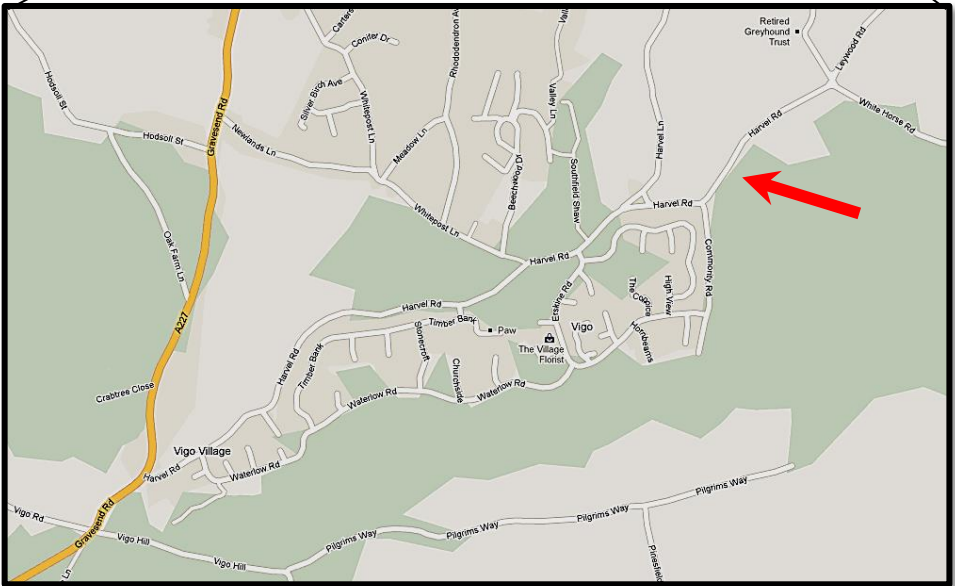
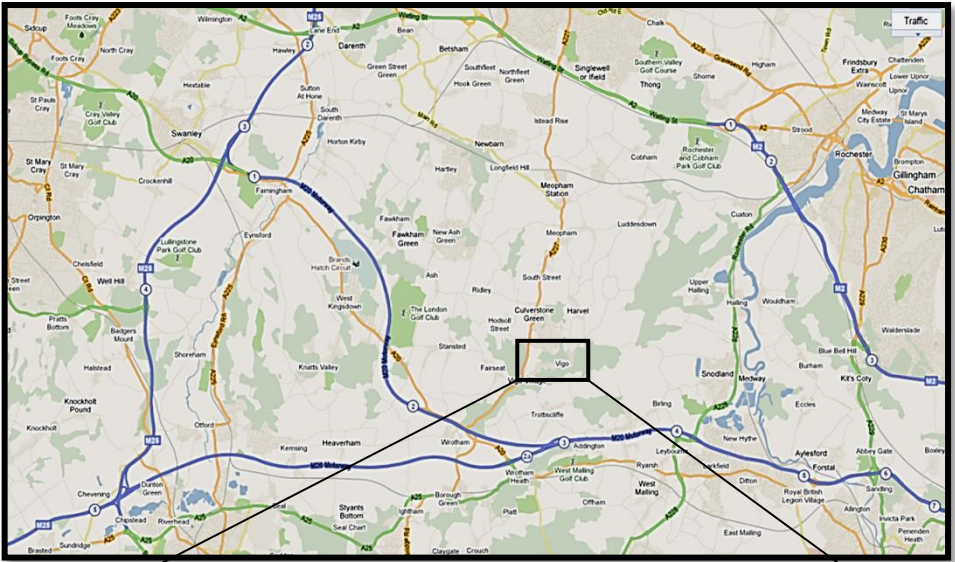
Awards:	Awards will be given in all categories according to the number of entries received and will only be available to competitors who shoot the round that starts with the recognised maximum distance for their gender & age. Juniors may not compete for senior awards, but separate awards will also be available for juniors who wish to shoot the senior round. Awards will be presented by the Lady Paramount as soon as possible after completion of shooting.
Rose Awards:	This tournament has 'Rose Award' status and competitors wishing to claim an award, must do so before they leave the venue.

Lost Arrows:	This tournament is held on a mixed-use sports field; if you lose any arrows, you must find them before you leave the venue.
Disclaimer:	Neither the Kent Archery Association nor the owners of the grounds can accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment while on, entering or leaving the venue. No responsibility will be accepted for damage to arrows missing or passing through a target boss.
Parking:	Parking space will be clearly indicated; please park considerately and do not leave your car on any roadway.
Photography:	To comply with the ArcheryGB Policy for "Safeguarding Children, Young People & Vulnerable Adults", any person wishing to pursue any form of photography for any purpose is required to report to the tournament organiser before starting and to comply with any conditions given.
